**\*This course will focus on weaving with clay**

*We will explore different weaving techniques, from the simplest interweaving of coils to more complex patterns such as vertical weaving that mimics wicker basketry. There will be opportunities to experiment with both white and red clays, and to make functional pieces or sculptural, abstract forms. This is a handbuilding course and therefore does not include throwing on the wheel.*

*Students enrolling in this course should be experienced and confident in handling clay and understand the basic pottery principles of coiling. All pieces made by learners are for them to keep at the end of the course. (Please note the dates of this course extend over school half term and so do not enrol if you are not able to attend all five weeks).*

**To attend these courses, you need to be:**

1. Aged 19 or older on 31 August 2025.
2. A citizen of the United Kingdom and Islands, have Right of Abode, or are a citizen of a country that is within the European Economic Area (EEA);
3. Have been an ordinarily resident in the United Kingdom and Islands or the European Union (EU) or the European Economic Area (EEA) continuously for at least the previous three years on the first day of learning;

**To be eligible for the concession rate, you must be able to provide evidence of receiving at least one of the following:**

- a. Job Seekers Allowance
- b. Council Tax Benefit
- c. Housing Benefit
- d. Income Support
- e. Universal Credits including pension credits
- f. Employment and Support Allowance in the Work-Related Activity Group (ESA WRAG)
